4. Sharing Your Information

- Google Analytics and Meta Pixel for website analytics and marketing insights
- CookiesYes for managaing website cookies

All partners are required to handle your data securely and in compliance with data protection law. We never sell your personal data to third parties.

5. Data Retention

We retain personal data only for as long as necessary for the purposes outlined in this policy, or as required by law. Once no longer needed, data is securely deleted or anonymised.

6. Your Rights
